### Hobbs, Jacks to play at Two Frogs this evening

Ardmore born and raised Jeff Hobbs and The Jacks will take the stage at Two Frogs Grill at 10 p.m. tonight. The cost is \$7 and there will be beer specials all night. This is the last holiday bash before Christmas at Two Frogs.

Jeff Hobbs and the Jacks' debut record, "Road To Nowhere," raises the bar of excellence in the independent music scene and has managed to wrangle a top-notch Austin based booking agency, an independent New York-based label and a pleasantly ferocious publicist (Brandy Reed, RPR Media) in one fell swoop. The current single, "Red River Anthem," is a fan favorite and most definitely one of the high-octane musical highlights of their live show.

Reed said she is "addicted to this record and out of all the musicians I have worked with in the last 11 years, Jeff Hobbs is hands down the very best singer/songwriter of them all."

"Jeff Hobbs is by far the best singer/songwriter I've worked with. The combination of Jeff with the Jacks makes for a dynamic live show that you want to see again and again." It is no small affair to be considered a tremendous talent by Alvin Moody, president of New York-based independent label Juell Records. Moody is a 20-year music veteran who in his tenure has worked with A-list artists such as Prince, Cher, Whitney Houston and Gavin DeGraw.
